SUMMARY

- Another weekend of football and some surprising results as all 8 teams start to find their feet in the SWL this year. Terrigal and Gosford continued their great start to the campaign with wins over East Gosford and Kanwal respectively. Umina continued their resurgence following a poor start to the season with a win over previously unbeaten Kincumber. Finally, Southern Ettalong managed to stop the rut of losing, sharing the spoils with draw specialists Woongarra.
- In Reserve Grade, it's a similar sort of story at the top. Gosford leading the way with Terrigal only behind on goal difference. Gosford were held by Kanwal, but Terrigal beat East Gosford to climb into 2nd spot. Umina climbed again following a smashing 6-1 win over Kincumber. Finally, Southern Ettalong managed to get 3 points on the board! A thumping 4-1 away from home at the hands of Woongarra brings them closer to leaving the summit of the ladder.

- 2 big games for Southern Ettalong and 2 positive results to take back to the Peninsula! In Reserve Grade, Woongarra have struggled to match their opening round victory but arguably have come up against 2 of the best sides in the competition in Gosford and Terrigal and would have looked at this game as one to get back to winning ways. Southern Ettalong have been on the wrong side of results every week with a demoralizing 9-0 defeat to Kanwal 2 weeks ago but they looked to have turned things around now. Goals from Courtney Harding, Emma Connolly and a brace from Kiara Kelly brought 3 points back home for the visitors. Woongarra did have a goal to celebrate though with

Nyah Small getting on the scoresheet. In First Grade, Woongarra were determined not to repeat that Reserve Grade performance and they managed to come out of the game with a point. This is the 3rd draw in their first 3 games but again, they have played 2 of the Competitions best sides in Terrigal and Gosford so they will be happy to have points on the board. Southern Ettalong were looking to avoid a 3rd straight defeat after defeats to Umina and Kanwal in recent weeks. Goals from either side scored by Tarra Southern for Woongarra and Taylor Thackaray for Southern Ettalong ensured both teams came home with something.

- Next week sees Southern Ettalong travelling to the league leaders Terrigal and it'll be tough to beat them seeing how well they're doing this season. Woongarra are back at Hamlyn Terrace Oval again where they'll host a Umina side looking for their 3rd straight win.

- 1st place versus 8th place today and a result that played how the table is reading. 6 points for Terrigal and they are looking good for 1st spot this year. East Gosford can't seem to buy a win at the minute in first grade, whereas Reserve Grade's win in Round 1 seems a long time ago now. In Reserve Grade, Terrigal were made to work for their 3 points and East Gosford weren't about to give in. Naomi Abbott was on the scoresheet for the Rams but 2 goals in the 2nd half from Tiegan Kavanagh and Grace O'Hara for Terrigal ensured the 3 points were heading their way. In First Grade, Terrigal carried on their fine form and subjected East Gosford to another defeat to make that 3 for the season. They face another difficult trip next to Kanwal but put up a good fight on Sunday. Kim Meyer scored a double for the girls in green but goals from Kayla Vanderfield and Jessie Andrew (2 each) were enough to cap off a great day for Terrigal.

- The top 2 in Reserve Grade took to battle at Wadalba Sports Complex and both sides couldn't do enough to take all 3 points. Goals from Kanwal's Michelle Bertucci kept the Bulls in the game whilst Sarah Marston + Maria Aspitia made sure Gosford took a point home. In First Grade, it was a different story with Gosford keeping the pressure on Terrigal at the top of the ladder. Kanwal First Grade have struggled for form this season and this fixture was always going to be tough going for them. Gosford, however, have gone from strength to strength with a minor blip drawing at Woongarra. - A 6 point weekend for Umina and they resurgence continued this week at Umina Oval with 8 goals over 2 games. Firstly, in Reserve Grade, Umina kickstarted their season last week with a win over local rivals Southern Ettalong and they carried on this fine form with a thumping 6-1 victory over a Kincumber side who's form has been indifferent following their solitary 3-2 win over East Gosford. Goals from Sam Fulwood, Amber Mangon and 4 from Abbie Dickson guaranteed victory for the Eagles on the day with Shivonne Blair scoring Kincumber consolation goal. In First Grade, Umina secured their 2nd straight away after 2 defeats to Gosford and Terrigal and they have risen up the ladder to 3rd following this victory. Goals from Danielle Harris and Kate Styles were enough to secure 3 points and give them more confidence ahead of their travel to Woongarra.
