**SUMMARY**

- We have a change in leaders at the top of the ladder following Terrigal's shock loss to Southern Ettalong who find themselves climbing the ladder. Gosford took advantage of that defeat and squeezed into first following their close 3-2 win over an improving Kincumber. Kanwal produced the Performance of the Round with a thumping 7-2 victory over East Gosford who are looking lonely at the bottom of the ladder. Elsewhere, Woongarra got their first win of the season over a Umina team that were on the up.
- In Reserve Grade, Terrigal's 5-0 win over Southern Ettalong pushed them to top spot but only on goal difference so all 5 goals counted on the day! Gosford aren't far behind following their convincing 3-0 win over Kincumber. Umina produced a magnificent away result, smashing Woongarra 8-0 in a game to forget for the Wildcats. Elsewhere, Kanwal and East Gosford shared the spoils at Wadalba Sports Complex drawing 3-3 in a goalfest 90 minutes.

**RESERVE GRADE GOSFORD (3) KINCUMBER (0)  
FIRST GRADE GOSFORD (3) KINCUMBER (2)**

- Our new leaders turned it up once again and took home 6 points again. With Terrigal's shock loss this weekend, Gosford will be looking to keep that 1<sup>st</sup> spot for the remainder of the season. In Reserve Grade, it was business as usual for the Dragons. Goals from Tayla Jowett, Maria Aspitia and Abbey Muspratt ensured the unbeaten run continued. In First Grade, it was a lot closer and a much better performance than last week which will please Kincumber's coach. Goals from Maddie Yates, Gemma O'Toole and Megan Sullivan ensured the 3 points today.

- Next up for Gosford is the improving Southern Ettalong who'll be looking to giant kill once again following their upset over Terrigal. Kincumber will host Terrigal who'll be looking to bounce back from that shock defeat. Kincumber will be looking for some points, hoping to build on their East Gosford win back on 15<sup>th</sup> April.

**RESERVE GRADE WOONGARRAH (0) UMINA (8)**  
**FIRST GRADE WOONGARRAH (3) UMINA (2)**

- A great result for Umina's Reserve Grade saw them climb into 3<sup>rd</sup> spot this week following Kanwal's draw with East Gosford. Goals from Sam Fulwood x2, Amber Mangan x2 and 4 from Abbie Dickson ensured the biggest result of the weekend and the performance of the round in Reserve Grade. That's the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive loss for the Wildcats and only Southern Ettalong keep them from the bottom of the ladder. A totally different story in First Grade however with Woongarra picking up their first win of the season! Umina have been improving over the last couple of weeks, picking up wins over Southern Ettalong and Kincumber, but Woongarra wanted it more at the end of the day. Goals from Laura Robertson x 2 and Emily Forbes were enough to give the home side 3 points. Notable mentions for Abbie Dickson (again) and Kate Styles for their goals in first grade. Kate Styles is slowly making her way up the goal scoring ladder and will be up there at the end of the season if she keeps up this form. Umina could have been coming home with a share of the spoils had they converted in the last 5 minutes!
- Next up for Woongarra is a travel down south to visit East Gosford who are looking for their first win of the season in First Grade. Reserve Grade might be a tougher outing for the Wildcats though with East Gosford firmly placed mid table. Umina are back on the road as well, visiting Kanwal at Wadalba Sports Complex. A very even encounter for both grades with both teams around the midtable mark in the ladder.
