SUMMARY

- Happy Mother's Day to all players, coaches and trainers in the SWL and beyond! It certainly was an entertaining day with 4 of the 8 matches played across both grades resulting in a 5-0 win! In First Grade, it was business as usual for Gosford and Terrigal who both collected 6 points against Southern Ettalong and Kincumber respectively. Umina climbed the ladder with a 2-0 win over Kanwal who are sliding down the ladder. Woongarra won again and found themselves in the top half of the ladder following a close 1-0 win over struggling East Gosford.
- In Reserve Grade, we have new leaders in Gosford, thanks to their 5-0 win over Southern Ettalong but Terrigal aren't far behind them. They beat Kincumber 3-1 yesterday and fall in 2nd place on goal difference but next week could change that. Kanwal smashed close rivals Umina 5-0 to keep the pressure on the big 2 at the top. Finally, East Gosford also won 5-0 over a disappointing Woongarra side still searching for a 2nd win following 4 straight losses.

- We start with the league leaders and we think they'll be leading for the majority of the season if they keep up performances from the previous few weeks. In Reserve Grade, it was a demolition derby with top against bottom and top prevailing. They've been a force all season so far with the blip in their record being a 2-2 draw with Kanwal but it was a business as usual with this win. - A share of the spoils at Hylton Moore Oval with both sides going away with 3 points to keep everyone happy! In Reserve Grade, East Gosford have improved over recent weeks, drawing last week with the impressive Kanwal and keeping Gosford and Terrigal to tight games. This week was their week though over a Woongarra side that are struggling for form. Goal scorers this week were Lucy Peters x 2, Annika Hansen x 2 and Sophie Halliday with the 5th goal. In First Grade, it was a different story. East Gosford have struggled for form for most of the season with a solitary draw against Kincumber to cheer about. Woongarra have done well so far this season with just the one loss at the hands of the free scoring Terrigal team, they've battled 3 draws out of 6 games including a 0-0 against Gosford and it was another close encounter today. From the sidelines, it was said to be a close game with East Gosford almost pipping them but a defensive lapse left East Gosford with a 2v1 at the back post and Neisha Monteleone was on hand to bring the 3 points back to Woongarra.
