SUMMARY

- A few surprising results this week with Terrigal slipping in First Grade to Kanwal and with Gosford winning at Umina, the gap stretches to 7 points at the top after only 8 games. East Gosford was probably the biggest surprise of the day though, defeating Southern Ettalong to register their first win of the season! Elsewhere, Hamlyn Terrace Oval was the place to be for goals as Woongarraah continued their solid form with a smashing 6-2 win over struggling Kincumber.
- In Reserve Grade, Gosford missed the chance to close the gap on leaders Kanwal as the Dragons slipped 2-0 to Umina. Terrigal were held by the goal hungry Kanwal 3-3 up at Wadalba Sports Complex. East Gosford defeated bottom placed Southern Ettalong 2-1 to ensure a 6 point day for SWL for the Rams and finally, Woongarraah and Kincumber gave us 11 goals in one game! The Wildcats got up 6-5 to push themselves away from the bottom of the pile.
- CCF have announced that along with the Battlewin Premier League North vs South game, the SWL will be represented in the North vs South game and will be the curtain raiser for the BPL game. This game will take place on Monday 11th June at 1pm. - 19 goals in 180 minutes of football! Goals were a plenty at Hamlyn Terrace Oval and these wins were vital for Woongarra in both divisions as they climbed to 3rd in 1st Grade and pushed themselves further away from bottom spot in Reserve Grade. We'll start with Reserve Grade and 2 players (1 from each team) scored 4 goals in the game, Keanah Scholes for Woongarra and 4 goals from Mia Barber for Kincumber! Kincumber led 4-1 at Half Time so it was a hell of a comeback from Woongarra. The deficit was narrowed thanks to Keanah to bring back to 4-2 but Kincumber quickly scored again to bring it to 5-2. Danielle Helou and Keanah scored to bring it back to 5-4 and Paige Verrankamp equalized to make it 5-5 with Keanah scoring the winning goal. In First Grade, Woongarra's form has been steady with only 1 loss from 7 games whilst Kincumber have struggled, sitting 7th on the ladder. However, it was Kincumber who took the lead through Georgah Shearim within 3 minutes. Emma Hurley was quick to equalize but Lauren Tindale brought the Roos back into the game. Laura Robertson equalized once again to level the game at half time at 2-2 and Coach Dave Hurley must have given a rousing speech at half time because we saw 4 more goals in only 1 direction in the 2nd half. Within 10 minutes, Woongarra had scored 3 goals with Neisha Monteleone and Emma Hurley scoring her 2nd and 3rd of the game and she managed to bag a 4th to complete a great day for Woongarra and bring home 6 points from 6 points.

However, 2 great results for Kanwal as they rise up the ladder in 1st Grade to 5th following Southern's loss at East Gosford. Reserve Grade climbed up to 2nd thanks to their superior goal difference over Gosford. Starting with Reserve Grade and Kanwal were up 1-0 at half time but Terrigal came out firing in the 2nd half, leading 3-1 at one point but Kanwal were determined to turn things around and managed to level the game up so both teams shared the spoils and put themselves above Gosford.
