#### **SUMMARY**

Gosford City have continued their unbeaten run in First grade with a convincing 3-0 win over Kincumber, while the Terrigal Reserve Grade side have also extended their lead at the top of the Reserve Grade table with a 5-1 win over Southern Ettalong. However, Southern Ettalong managed to get the better of Terrigal in First Grade, beating the second placed team 2-1.

The top 4 on the Reserve Grade table remain tight, with only 3 points separating 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place. Gosford maintain their 13-point lead at the top of the First-Grade ladder, whilst Terrigal, Umina, Southern Ettalong and Kanwal rounding out the top 5, separated by only 2 points, with Woongarra nipping at their heels. Coming into the back end of the season, Gosford look set to take out the top spot, however the other three places in the finals could be anyone's.

**Reserve Grade: Terrigal (5) V (1) Southern Ettalong**

**First Grade: Terrigal (1) V (2) Southern Ettalong**

Terrigal United hosted Southern Ettalong, and Terrigal Reserve Grade got off to a flying start. A strong game played by both sides saw Terrigal come out on top, with Elly Bibby dominating the game and scoring a hat trick in the first half. The team only gained momentum in the second half, with Emma Norro and Grace Ohara also scoring to ensure Terrigal secured three points and held their spot at the top of the Reserve Grade table. Natalie Waddell netted Southern Ettalong's goal, taking away the clean sheet from a strong Terrigal side.

First Grade saw both teams with a number of chances, as Southern Ettalong put on a strong defensive display holding the Terrigal attack to go into halftime nil all. Kayla Vanderfield opened the scoring for Terrigal in the second half from a free kick, scoring her 9<sup>th</sup> goal for the season. Southern responded quickly to this, scoring an equaliser off the boot of Jewel Finney. Before managing to close out the game in the 82<sup>nd</sup> minute via Tahlor Thackray, denying Terrigal the points. A tightly contested match between two strong teams, with Southern recomposing themselves to come back and take the win.

It was a family affair at the Kincumber V Gosford games at Frost Reserve on Sunday, as Kincumber's Coach came up against his daughter in the Gosford side. Kincumber, despite being unable to score on the day, did well against a strong Gosford side. Goals to Laura Mundy, Taylor Thompson and 2 to Abbey Muspratt sealed the 4-0 win for Gosford in Reserve Grade.

The result of the First-Grade game was similar to Reserves, with Kincumber showing strength and playing well against the competition leaders. Goals to Megan Sullivan, Gemma O'Toole and Taylor Thompson rounded out the 3-0 win to Gosford. A special mention to Taylor Thompson, scoring for Gosford in both Reserve and First Grade games, as well as Jessika Manners, playing goalkeeper in Reserve Grade before playing in the backline for First Grade.
