SUMMARY

- Early rain halted 2 of the 8 games this weekend with Duffy's Oval closed which will leave Terrigal and Umina with a midweek game in July to make up the round. Elsewhere, it was business as usual for Gosford who saw off the challenge of Woongarra despite the injuries piling up for the Dragons. East Gosford's rise continues and they find themselves off the bottom of the ladder, putting Kincumber in 8th place following their 3-1 win at Frost Reserve. Finally, Kanwal lifted themselves into 3rd place following their 2-1 win over Southern Ettalong.
- In Reserve Grade, Terrigal keep their top spot despite not playing but their lead is shortened to 1 point with Kanwal defeating bottom placed Southern Ettalong 2-0. Gosford keep up the pressure on Kanwal with a thumping 8-1 win over Woongarra and East Gosford's first half performance was enough to see Kincumber off, winning 2-0.
- There will be NO games and NO report next week as the games for Round 10 have been rescheduled for Wednesday 20th June and Thursday 28th June to accommodate for Monday's North vs South game.

- Another 6 point day for East Gosford and they could get used to that feeling! The Rams will be happy to find themselves climbing the ladder in both grades and they move themselves off the bottom of the ladder in First Grade. Kincumber now hold that honour and East Gosford will be trying their hardest to avoid returning to the depths of 8th Place. We start in Reserve Grade and 2 first half goals were enough to secure the 3 point. Kirsty Wright added to her tally and Erica Fardy scored from a Free Kick. In First Grade, East Gosford were looking to build on last week's result against Southern Ettalong, whereas Kincumber were reeling from the 6-2 loss to Woongarra. East Gosford came out and took the game to the hosts with Sophie Holliday, Mel Frazer and Naomi Abbott all scoring in the first half to give East Gosford a commanding lead. Kincumber reacted in the 2nd half with a better performance and Emily Smith managed to grab a consolation goal for the Roos but it was destined to be East Gosford's day.
- Next up for Kincumber is the visit of Umina who will be fresh from missing out on playing this week against Terrigal. East Gosford travel to Terrigal who will also be fresh from their week off but it'll be a stern challenge for the Rams to continue their uprising.

- Coach Jorge Chavez will be very happy with today's results and 12 goals in 2 games for his beloved Dragons. It was a tight first half in Reserve Grade and Gosford led at the break 2-1. Woongarra had a penalty saved in the first half but Laura Robertson managed to get on the scoresheet. The 2nd half was a much different half as Gosford ran rampant over the Wildcats. Goals from Briana Green, Abbey Muspratt, Jordan Warbrick and 4 from Laura Mundy ensured the points were staying at Gavenlock today. In First Grade, Gosford were determined not to drop points again after Woongarra managed to scrape a draw in the reverse fixture earlier in the season. It was a nightmare start for the league leaders as an own goal put them behind and this was only the 2nd time in the season where they have been behind. Gemma O'Toole brought Gosford back into the game though with a Free Kick just outside the box. In the 35th minute, Megan Sullivan was found from a killer pass courtesy of Jessica Dominello and she put the Dragons ahead to leave the game poised nicely at 2-1 at the break. The 2nd half began and it was much the same with Gosford playing most of the game in Woongarra's half, Megan Sullivan was on the scoresheet again in the 76th minute. Finally Jessica Dominello managed to grab a goal for herself in the 80th minute to finish the game off. 4-1 and a fair result from all sides.

In First Grade, it was a scrappy, stop start game thanks to the weather conditions. Kanwal opened the scoring when Ashley Kirk set up Jo Walker who tapped in to make it 1-0 at half time. Kanwal came out firing in the Second Half and Michelle Bertucci continued her goal scoring antics with a volley to double the lead.
