### SUMMARY

Round 14 saw a Saturday night game played under lights at Wadalba between Kanwal and Woongarrah, with Kanwal coming away with all 6 points. This Round also saw SWL heavyweights Terrigal and Gosford face each other at Gavenlock Oval. In two closely matched games, Gosford managed to come away with wins in both grades- ending Terrigal's unbeaten run in Reserve Grade and knocking them off the top spot with goal difference. The race to the League Championship between these two sides is really heating up. In other games, East Gosford and Umina drew in both grades, whilst Kincumber and Southern Ettalong also had close results. After defeating Terrigal 3-2 in First Grade, a win for Gosford against Umina this weekend will see them seal the League Champions title.

#### **Reserve Grade: Kanwal (6) V Woongarrah (0)**

Kanwal welcomed rivals Woongarrah on a cold and windy Saturday night at Wadalba. Kanwal Reserve Grad used their experience from kick off and managed to get the upper hand over a young and energetic Woongarrah side. Marie Tapsell opened the scoring before Hayley Green slotted the first of her hat trick. Adina Hawkins added a third goal to the scoreboard as Kanwal took control before the break. Woongarrah had a number of chances however struggled to convert as an experienced Kanwal team dominated the game. The second half saw Kanwal net another 3 goals, with 2 to Hayley Green and 1 to Marie Tapsell, taking the final score line to 6-0.

#### **First Grade: Kanwal (3) V Woongarrah (0)**

First Grade saw a tight encounter in the first half as both sides traded blows without ever really threatening to score. A number of chances to both teams went unfinished as the Kanwal and Woongarrah sides headed into the sheds nil all at halftime. The second half was a different story as Kanwal came out firing with Michelle Bertucci scoring in the first 10 minutes from close range, before Hayley Ballard double the lead not long after with a header. Jo Walker rounded out the scoring for the night with a far post tap in, giving Kanwal a 3-0 win.

### **Reserve Grade: Kincumber (0) V Southern Ettalong (0)**

Reserve Grade was a tight affair between 6<sup>th</sup> placed Kincumber and 8<sup>th</sup> placed Southern Ettalong on Sunday, with the game finishing in a scoreless draw. With both teams sitting on only 2 wins for the season and 6 points apiece, it was an even contest. Both teams had a number of chances score but failed to convert, with both teams dominating in the middle of the pitch. After 90 minutes and not a goal scored, the game finished up nil all, as both teams took away a point each, with no changes in the ladder standings.

### **First Grade: Kincumber (0) V Southern Ettalong (1)**

First Grade began much the same way as Reserve Grade, with both teams having a number of chances but failing to convert. With only 2 wins for the season so far, Kincumber were eager to beat a 5<sup>th</sup> placed Southern Ettalong side. However, Tatum Ansiewicz was the first and only goal scorer of the day, scoring for Southern Ettalong to ultimately give them the win and 3 points.

### **Reserve Grade: East Gosford (1) V Umina (1)**

Umina struggled this week against a lower placed East Gosford side, as injuries riddled the team, with only 8 First Grade and 10 Reserve Grade players available for the day. East Gosford took full advantage against a depleted Umina squad as they came out firing. Both teams had a number of chances at goal but were failing to convert. Naomi Abbot netted East Gosford's only goal of the game, whilst Abbie Dickson netted one for Umina. In a game of back and forth, these two goals would prove to be the only of the game, as the score finished up 1-1, and a point was given to each team.

### **First Grade: East Gosford (1) V Umina (1)**

It proved to be a repeat of the first game as First Grade took the field at Hylton Moore on Sunday. With only 8 starting First Grade players for Umina, East Gosford were in with a chance to get themselves off the bottom of the ladder and they came out enthusiastic and ready to play. Much like the Reserve Grade game, it was an evenly matched event with both teams having chances to get on the scoreboard but failing to do so. Kim Meyer once again got herself on the scoreboard for East Gosford, whilst Letisha McCormack scored Umina's only goal of the game, taking the final score to another 1-1 result.

### **Reserve Grade: Gosford (3) V Terrigal (1)**

The Gosford versus Terrigal clash was the most anticipated match up of the Round, with both teams holding the two top spots in Reserve Grade and First Grade. Gosford started the game with a bang, scoring in the first 30 seconds through Laura Mundy on her first touch of the ball. This startled an unprepared Terrigal side, as Gosford created numerous goal scoring opportunities within the first 15 minutes of the game, with Tayla Jowett looking destined to score on 2 occasions with only the woodwork to deny her. Gosford then doubled their lead in the 25<sup>th</sup> minute through Laura Mundy, with her second for the day. Going into the halftime break, 2-0 down, Terrigal looked to get back into the game in the second half. A penalty to Nicole Bennett for Terrigal narrowed the score for a short time before Gosford closed out the match and sealed their win with a goal to Tayla Jowett. The 3-1 win to Gosford sees them be the first team to beat the Terrigal Reserve Grade this season and take over the top spot on the ladder due to goal difference, despite Terrigal still having a game in hand.

### **First Grade: Gosford (3) V Terrigal (2)**

Terrigal came into this First Grade match up firing, as they looked to defeat an unbeaten Gosford side. The top of the table clash saw Terrigal score first, as a cross from Jordan Hunter found Jonelle Tomson who put the ball in the back of the net. Terrigal continued with several more chances, however, Gosford found the back of the net through Taylor Thompson in the 39<sup>th</sup> minute to even the score. A clumsy challenge in the box just before half time gifted Gosford their second goal from the penalty spot with Maddie Yates scoring her second penalty in 2 weeks. Terrigal came out after halftime enthusiastic and ready to play, with both teams again having a number of chances to score but failing to do so. Jessica Dominello then got onto the score sheet to make it 3-1 to Gosford. With both Jessica Dominello and Kayla Vanderfield fighting for the Golden Boot this year, Kayla made sure she kept her goal tally climbing, scoring Terrigal's second for the day which made for an interesting final 10 minutes. Terrigal had a few good chances in the final 5 minutes to take a point away but somehow Gosford managed to keep them out. Both matches were exactly what you would expect from two top of the table clashes!
