ROUND 10: Wednesday 27th & Thursday 28th June

Reserve Grade: Woongarra (2) V (5) Terrigal

Terrigal Reserve Grade turned their flat start to the game around quickly after Woongarra scored early through Tilly Sultana. Woongarra applied pressure upfront, however Terrigal defence managed to hold strong. Emma Noro scored in the 13th minute for Terrigal, giving the team the nudge they needed to lift and play their own game. A second goal came for Terrigal in the 25th minute through a long cross from Tiegan Kavanagh to be knocked in by Grace O'Hara, giving Terrigal a 2-1 lead. The second half saw both teams come out strong, with Talissa Mackenzie opening the second half scoring with a long-range goal from midfield. Woongarra weren't going to be deterred and kept the pressure up with a second goal to Tilly Sultana. However, Terrigal managed to finish strong with another two goals by Maddie Tyson and Elly Bibby taking the final score to 5-2 to Terrigal.

First Grade: Woongarra (0) V (2) Terrigal

The Terrigal versus Woongarra 1st Grade game was a battle of two strong teams, both showing patience, persistence, precise passing, and sheer determination to win. Terrigal managed to prevail in this game and take away the three points, after a hard fought 90 minutes. The scoring wasn't opened until the 71st minute, as Terrigal's patience paid off with a penalty goal to Kayla Vanderfield. 7 minutes later, Jess Wrigley secured the win for Terrigal putting another goal into the back of the net.

Reserve Grade: Kanwal (4) V (0) Kincumber

Kanwal put on a dominate display over Kincumber during their midweek Round 10 game at Plum Park. Goals from Emma Raychaudhuri, an own goal and one to Hayley Green saw the score 3-0 at the half time break. The second half was a tighter affair, with Kincumber putting on a good display of defence, with only one goal scored through Hayley Green, her second for the day. Kanwal took home the three points with a 4-nil win.

First Grade: Kanwal (4) V (1) Kincumber

The Kanwal versus Kincumber game saw a tight, evenly matched game in the opening 20 minutes, with both teams having a number of chances to score throughout the first half. A couple of near misses to Kanwal, and a several great saves from the Kincumber goalkeeper had everyone on the edge of their seats, however, the game went into the break nil all. The second half was a different story, as Kanwal came out firing and scored in the first 5 minutes, as Marie Tapsell pounced on a loose ball and scored in an empty net. Kincumber responded not long after, as a goalkeeper error led Emily Smith to equalise for Kincumber. Michelle Bertucci quickly made it 3-1 for Kanwal, before Jennifer Reeves sealed the game with a long bomb into the top corner, taking the final score to 4-1.

Reserve Grade: East Gosford (0) V (5) Gosford

The midweek local derby between these two sides saw East Gosford facing tough competition in SWL heavyweights Gosford City. The Reserve Grade game saw Gosford's Sarah Macpherson score her first hat trick of the season, whilst Laura Mundy also added her name to the score board again this week. Bree-Anna McFarlane also managed to get onto the scoreboard towards the end of the game, to make it a comfortable 5-0 win to Gosford. Both teams then had to turn around and prepare to play again on Sunday.

First Grade: East Gosford (0) V (8) Gosford

Both teams were excited to be playing a night game under lights at Plum Park, however it was competition leaders Gosford who came away with a confident win. Jessica Dominello was on a mission to score a few goals, and she didn't disappoint scoring 5 goals for the night. SUMMARY

Another big week in the Sea FM Women's League! 6 of the 8 teams played midweek games this week, which would have tested team's fitness levels. As this time of the season approaches, teams are plagued with injury, illness and players away on other commitments, with many teams having players play in both grades. After 2 big wins midweek, Gosford were held to a much closer score line by Southern Ettalong. Closely matched teams Kanwal and Umina faced off, with Umina managing to take away all 6 points. In 1st Grade, Kincumber managed to upset second placed Terrigal, beating them 1-0.

Reserve Grade: Southern Ettalong (0) V Gosford (2)

With 8 players unable to take the field for Gosford, their Reserve Grade side took the field with a mixed and shuffled line up. Both teams fought hard in a close game, however Gosford's fitness toward the end of each half helped them prevail and come away with the three points. Goals to Megan Sullivan and Taylor Thompson helped secure the win for Gosford. Southern Ettalong created opportunities and were unlucky not to pick up a goal or two themselves. Both teams will look forward to a week without midweek games and will prepare for their respective matches next Sunday. Gosford will welcome a few key players back next week for a top of the table clash with Terrigal, whilst Southern Ettalong will take on Kincumber.

1st Grade: Southern Ettalong (1) V Gosford (2)

With Southern Ettalong defeating Umina and Terrigal in the past week, and Gosford struggling for players, Gosford knew they were in for a challenging game. Southern Ettalong didn't disappoint, as they came out firing and playing a new gutsy 3-2-3-2 formation. The game started with a very high tempo, with a number of chances for both sides. Both midfield combinations worked well for their respected teams, and it was an error in Gosford's goal box late in the first half that saw Southern Ettalong seize the lead through Tatum Ansiewicz. This goal took Southern Ettalong one goal up into the half time break. The second half was again a battle of the midfield with both teams creating chances, and with 10 minutes to go it looked like Southern Ettalong were about to give Gosford City their first taste of defeat this year. Unfortunately for Southern Ettalong, Gosford were awarded a penalty with about 15 minutes to play which was converted

coolly by Maddie Yates, to level the scores 1 all. With about 5 minutes to play, Gosford managed to slip a ball through Southern's backline, with Jess Dominello finishing it to score her 11th goal for the season and win the game for Gosford. A tough fought game for both teams.

Reserve Grade: Umina (2) V Kanwal (1)

Reserve Grade saw a tight affair between Umina and Kanwal, with Umina jumping out of the gates fast with 2 early goals. They looked threatening every time they went forward, however Kanwal's defence did well to limit them. Kanwal finally started to gain a foothold in the match towards the end of the first half but couldn't reduce the deficit. The second half was totally different, as Kanwal came out firing and holding the ascendancy but were unable to convert. Umina posed a massive threat on the counter attack, but it was Kanwal who finally broke through with Lauren Hetherington scoring from long range. Try as they might, Kanwal just couldn't find the equaliser as Umina held on for a deserved 2-1 win.

1st Grade: Umina (2) V Kanwal (0)

The 1st Grade match up was almost a carbon copy of Reserve Grade, as Umina started on fire and dominated the game for the first 20 minutes. A number of chances to Umina could've seen the score line end up a lot larger, if it wasn't for a number of great saves from Kanwal goalkeeper Adina Hawkins. Kanwal tried valiantly to fight back but Umina held strong and led 2-0 at halftime. The second half saw Kanwal look more threatening as their midfield started to take control of the game. Umina were restricted to counter attacks, which they did very well, and they defended resolutely to keep Kanwal at bay. The final score 2-nil to Umina.

Reserve Grade: Terrigal (4) V Kincumber (1)

Terrigal opened the scoring first on Sunday, with a goal to Maddy Tyson in the 4th minute. Emma Norro followed form in the 17th minute for Terrigal before Trinity Martinac scored in the 38th minute to go to the half time break 3-nil up over Kincumber. Kincumber themselves had a number of chances in the first half, as the Terrigal defence struggled and worked hard to keep them goalless on a very boggy pitch. The second half saw Kincumber come out with urgency, scoring through Kate Gilbert. The Kincumber defence held Terrigal out for the better part of the second half, and it was only a goal to Elly Bibby in the 77th minute that got through, finishing the game 4-1.

1st Grade: Terrigal (0) V Kincumber (1)

This game saw second placed Terrigal take on 7th placed Kincumber, in a game which many assumed Terrigal would win. With only 6 fresh players in 1st Grade, and the rest of the team made up of players backing up from Reserve Grade, Kincumber were up against it. However, Kincumber caused the upset of the Round, playing extremely well and out enthusing Terrigal on the pitch, which resulted in Kincumber scoring in the 20th minute through Sophie Piltz. Terrigal went to the break 1 nil down and despite being in Kincumber's half for majority of second half, Kincumber's strong defence kept Terrigal scoreless. This saw Kincumber take away 3 points in 1st grade for only the second time this season, and they will be looking to continue this winning form on Sunday against Southern Ettalong.

Reserve Grade: Woongarra (1) V East Gosford (2)

The Woongarra versus East Gosford match was a tightly contested game between two closely matched sides. Both teams were coming off midweek matches against the two front runners of Reserve Grade- Terrigal and Gosford and were looking for a win. Both teams created a number of chances throughout the game, with good displays of defence really shown. The close game saw East Gosford come out on top, with a 2-1 win. Naomi Abbott managed to score both goals for East Gosford, whilst Keneah Scholes scored Woongarra's goal for the game.

1st Grade: Woongarra (1) V East Gosford (1)

Much like Reserve Grade, the 1st Grade contest between Woongarra and East Gosford saw another tightly contested match. Emma Hurley once again got herself on the scoreboard, scoring Woongarra's only goal for the game, whilst Ella Girling netted the goal for East Gosford. A close match, saw both teams deservedly take home a point each. They will both be looking forward to having the week off, after playing 3 games in the space of 8 days.
