Summary

The SWL Match of the Round between Southern Ettalong and Terrigal saw Terrigal scrape by with a 2-1 win. In 1st Grade, competition leaders Gosford comfortably defeated Kincumber 6-1, whilst 6th placed Woongarra managed to hold 2nd place Umina to a 2 all draw. Kanwal put 6 past East Gosford as their late charge for the finals continues. Reserve Grade sees Gosford and Terrigal both still fighting it out for the Minor Premiership on 42 points apiece, with Gosford sitting ahead on goal difference.

Reserve Grade: Kanwal (2) V (0) East Gosford

Kanwal hosted East Gosford in a game that never reached any great heights. East Gosford were gallant but were extremely under manned and try as they might, they just didn't have the firepower to trouble Kanwal. Kanwal scored first when Lauren Hetherington pounced on a mix up between keeper and defender to slot into an empty net. This was to be the only goal of the first half, with Kanwal going into the game 1 nil up. The second half saw Kanwal dominate and have a number of chances on goal, before Adina Hawkins fired in a free kick to double the lead. East Gosford held on well to keep the score at 2-0 as Kanwal came away with the three points and remain in contention for the top spot.

First Grade: Kanwal (6) V (0) East Gosford

With both sides coming off encouraging results last week, this game was expected to be extremely close. Unfortunately for East Gosford, no one told Kanwal that as they were rampant in the opening half. Hayley Ballard scored in the second minute from a corner, before Jo Walker scored to make it 2-0 to Kanwal. 2 goals from the head of Courtney Smith quickly made it 4-0 and Ashley Kirk rounded off the 1st half scoring with a goal 5 minutes before half time. The 2nd half saw East Gosford dig in deep and really take the game to Kanwal but never really threatened, as Jo Walker scored her 2nd of the game to finish the scoring, a 6 nil win to Kanwal.

Reserve Grade: Woongarra (1) V (4) Umina

This game saw 8th place Woongarra take on 4th place Umina. Woongarra came out ready to take on 4th place and fought valiantly. Umina showed their Keanah Scholes got on the scoreboard for Woongarra, whilst for Umina Abbie Dickson scored herself a double, Sam Fulwood and Amber Yunn also netted a goal each. Umina's 4-1 win over Woongarra was soured, as goalscorer Abbie Dickson fractured her wrist during play, which puts her in serious doubt for finals.

First Grade: Woongarra (2) V (2) Umina

This clash proved to be the upset of the round, as 6th place Woongarra held 2nd place Umina to a 2 all draw. Both teams came out ready to play and got off to a good start. A number of chances for both teams went unfinished, with both goalkeepers keeping their respective teams in the game. Golden Boot contender Kate Styles got on the scoresheet for Umina, alongside Maddie Magee with her first goal since Round 6. On the scoreboard for Woongarra were Emma Hurley, netting her 11th of the season, as well as Tilly Sultana. In a well fought game, Woongarra showed their strength to hold Umina to a 2 all draw and were unlucky not to snag the 3 points.

Reserve Grade: Southern Ettalong (1) V (2) Terrigal

This game got off to a flying start, with Elly Bibby scoring for Terrigal in just the 36th second through some good play in the midfield. This early goal startled Southern Ettalong and shook them into action. SEU got their way back into the game and started to create a number of chances on goal, and were rewarded in the 10th minute, as a poor clearance from Terrigal led to an own goal. The game was now 1 all and getting closer to the halftime break. Terrigal worked hard to score a second goal just before half time with a through ball to Elly Bibby and a cross to Jess Wrigley that was nicely placed in the bottom corner, 2-1 at halftime. The second half was much the same as the first as Terrigal came out pushing for more goals with the SEU keeper making a number of good saves to keep her team in the game. An injury to the keeper in the last 5 minutes saw the clock run down with no additional score in the second half. The final score a 2-1 win to Terrigal.

First Grade: Southern Ettalong (1) V (2) Terrigal

The First Grade clash between Southern Ettalong and Terrigal went much the same way as the Reserve Grade game. The clash between the 3rd and 4th placed teams saw SEU open the scoring after a handball in the box led to a penalty which was slotted coolly by Tahlor Thackray. Terrigal worked hard to get themselves back in the game, with both team's goalkeepers called into action early, making a number of goal-stopping saves. Just before halftime Jo Thomson managed to find the back of the net for Terrigal, taking the game into halftime 1 all. Terrigal took the lead early in the second half after a nice through ball to Jo Thomson left her one on one with the SEU keeper, as she guided the ball into the net past a diving keeper. Southern Ettalong kept pressing and searching for an equaliser however it was not to be, as Terrigal managed to hold out for a 2-1 win and the three points.

Reserve Grade: Gosford (6) V (2) Kincumber

Kincumber knew they were up for a challenge this game, taking on top of the table Gosford. However, this didn't dampen their spirits as they came out firing and ready to play. The young Kincumber side did well to hold Gosford's attack, however, Gosford were just too strong and experienced. Dominating possession, Gosford had Kincumber on the back foot for majority of the game. Laura Mundy bagged herself 4 goals for the day, whilst Tayla Jowett and Maria Aspitia rounded out Gosford's scoring for the day. Bianca Beehag had a stand out game for Kincumber, netting herself a double. Kincumber will look to redeem themselves next week against Terrigal at Frost Reserve.

First Grade: Gosford (6) V (1) Kincumber

In a top versus bottom of the table clash, Kincumber did well to hold their own and keep the League Champions to 6 goals, and net one against them. Helaina Wellington netted Kincumber's goal for the day, doing well to break down Gosford's strong defence. Gosford looked dominate and comfortable for the majority of the game, making the most of their chances on goal. Golden Boot frontrunner Jess Dominello furthered her lead, netting herself a hatrick for Gosford. Megan Sullivan scored herself a double, taking her tally to 10 for the season, with Maddie Yates rounding out the scoring for Gosford. A comfortable win for 1st place, as they turn their attention to this weekend's game against 4th place Southern Ettalong who are looking to cement their position in the finals.
