#### Summary

As Round 20 wraps up, the top 4 teams in Reserve Grade are clear cut, and will see Gosford, Terrigal, Umina and Kanwal face off in the finals. The League Championship will come down to the final round with both Gosford and Terrigal Reserve Grade sides on 45 points, after both winning their respective games on the weekend. It is only fitting that the final game of the regular season will see these two teams face off to decide who will take the top spot for the 2018 SWL Reserve Grade season.

In First Grade, the top 4 spots are all but wrapped up, with Southern Ettalong currently holding 4<sup>th</sup> spot, with Kanwal following just 1 point behind. Kanwal will be chasing a win against 6<sup>th</sup> place Woongarra and hoping their counterparts SEU slip up against in form 8<sup>th</sup> place Kincumber side. Terrigal and Umina First Grade sides are sitting equal on 36 points and an equal goal difference coming into the last round, whilst Gosford have the top spot all wrapped up with a massive 20-point lead.

#### **Reserve Grade: Gosford (4) V (1) Southern Ettalong**

Southern Ettalong started this game down on troops and only one reserve player on the bench. The game started even with both teams creating chances, with Gosford's goalkeeper pulling off a full-length diving save to the right in the first 15 minutes. After this, Gosford started to get themselves in the game, and began to dominate, putting a nice through ball to the striker Abbie Muspratt to run onto and open the scoring. Gosford continued to create chances and added another two goals prior to the break, through a double from Laura Mundy in the 28<sup>th</sup> minute and the 41<sup>st</sup> minutes. Gosford went into halftime with a 3-nil lead. The second half

started much like the first, with an even contest between the two teams. Gosford managed to get on the scoreboard again in the 64<sup>th</sup> minute through Jordan Warbrick before Southern Ettalong did their best to work their way back into the game. Southern's efforts were rewarded when a free kick from halfway was chipped over the set backline for Erin Wakefield to run onto it and slot the ball past the keeper. This took the final score to 4-1 to Gosford.

### **First Grade: Gosford (2) V (0) Southern Ettalong**

This game was evenly contested and a fast pace with both teams pressing their opposition when they did not have the ball. The 15 minute mark saw Gosford make a quick break down the right hand side of the field, and a low hard cross was finished off by Taylor Thompson to open the scoring for Gosford. The game continued in a back and forth fashion, with both teams struggling to break down their opponent's backline. Going into the sheds at halftime, Gosford held a 1 nil lead. The second half the game started just as strong as the first, with a continued fast pace. Southern Ettalong created a number of great chances on goal, but the Gosford defence held strong. It was a defensive error at the other end of the park by Southern that allowed Gosford to add another goal to their tally in the 61<sup>st</sup> minute through Megan Sullivan. As time wound down Gosford held firm to close out the game, defeating Southern Ettalong 2 nil.

### **Reserve Grade: Kincumber (1) V (2) Terrigal**

Terrigal came out firing in this game against a 7<sup>th</sup> place Kincumber outfit, as Willow Shorrocks chipped the Kincumber goalkeeper to score in the 3<sup>rd</sup> minute of play. Due to an unfortunate injury in the 15<sup>th</sup> minute, the game was delayed until the ambulance arrived. We wish Elizabeth Kelly a quick recovery after breaking her collarbone in a tackle. Play continued after this, with Terrigal giving away a penalty just after the halftime break, as Shivvy Blair levelled the score for Kincumber. Kincumber fought hard against a strong Kincumber side, however could not contain Willow Shorrocks, as she scored her second goal of the game for Terrigal, giving them the lead in the 57<sup>th</sup> minute. The game continued to be a tight match, with Terrigal holding out to come away with the three points.

### **First Grade: Kincumber (2) V (4) Terrigal**

Terrigal started the game slowly and Kincumber took advantage and scored early through Emily Smith. Terrigal didn't let this get them down as they kicked into gear and persisted. Kayla Vanderfield broke through and evened the scoring in the 11<sup>th</sup> minute off a corner. Terrigal began to dominate the game, as Courtney Muir scored Terrigal's second goal of the day from a Kayla Vanderfield cross to give them the lead. Kincumber were not done yet, as they equalised soon after through Helaina Wellington and held Terrigal out of the game until the 81<sup>st</sup> minute. Jonelle Thomson finally managed to break through the Kincumber defence to give Terrigal the lead once more, before Kayla Vander field managed to net her second of the day and seal the win for Terrigal in the 88<sup>th</sup> minute, taking the score to 4-2.

### **Reserve Grade: Kanwal (0) V (1) Umina**

This game was a must win for both teams, as they sat equal on 40 points, and a goal difference of 41, after the end of Round 19. Both teams came out firing and ready to play, determined to get the win. A number of chances on goal for each team went astray, as they both struggled to break down their respective opposition's backline. Umina were the team to break the deadlock, scoring through the likes of Kate Styles to take a 1 nil lead over Kanwal. Kanwal desperately tried to break down Umina's defence but it was not to be, as Umina held out the home team to take home the 3 points and climb to outright 3<sup>rd</sup> place on the ladder.

### **First Grade: Kanwal (1) V (2) Umina**

This 5<sup>th</sup> V 3<sup>rd</sup> clash between Umina and Kanwal saw the home team up against it from the start. Umina came out strong, with the majority of play happening in the middle of the field. Both teams had a number of chances to on goal, as Kate Styles managed to score both of Umina's goals in a stand out performance, after scoring

the winner in the Reserve Grade match up as well. Hayley Ballard also got herself onto the scoresheet, keeping Kanwal's hopes in this game alive, as well as Ballard's chances of the Golden Boot heading into the final round. Umina managed to hold the lead against Kanwal and take home the 3 points, defeating the home team 2-1.

### Reserve Grade: East Gosford (1) V (0) Woongarra

The Reserve Grade East Gosford V Woongarra game was a low scoring affair at a windy Hylton Moore Oval on Sunday. Both teams came out ready to play and had a number of chances on goal and just could not find the back of the net. The wind played havoc on long balls, causing chaos on the field and forcing the teams to find another way around their opposition's backline. East Gosford managed to net the only goal of the game through Tahlia Easton. They then managed to hold Woongarra out for the remainder of the game to defeat Woongarra 1 nil and take home the 3 points.

### First Grade: East Gosford (1) V (2) Woongarra

Woongarra came out firing in this game, catching an unprepared East Gosford side by surprise in the 3<sup>rd</sup> minute with a goal to Neisha Montelone. Woongarra continued their dominance in the first half, controlling the game and creating a number of chances. Neisha Montelone then managed to net her second goal of the day, giving Woongarra a 2-nil lead. The wind played havoc on this game, creating difficulty when playing long balls. The second half saw both teams adapt to these conditions, with Kim Meyers scoring for East Gosford with about 10 minutes to go, taking the final score to 2-1 to Woongarra.
