#### **FIRST GRADE: KILLARNEY DISTRICT 4 BERKELEY VALE 2**

- Killarney District have taken out the Battlewin Premier League premiership with a 4-2 win over Berkeley Vale in the 2018 Grand Final. In doing so they become just the second club to win three straight premierships joining Wyoming who achieved the feat between 1978 and 1980. However the Terriers do now have one record on their own becoming the first club since the start of the top Senior Competition in 1965 to win three successive league championship/premiership doubles. - Unfortunately for Berkeley Vale the loss added yet another chapter to their sad grand final tale having now been beaten in all six appearances although they did have the consolation of taking out the Reserve Grade premiership, their third win in the past seven seasons. That result also

prevented Killarney District from making their second clean sweep of all three BPL grade premiership.

- The opening goal came in the 18th minute following a Killarney corner that the Berkeley defence failed to clear allowing John Whelpdale to place a precise cross into the goalmouth which after a tight scramble fell to Sam Kirk to score. Three minutes later the Terriers were in again this time after some brilliant work by right back Bryce Fielder who started by cutting out a Berkeley Vale attack on the edge of his own penalty box then made a long run down the right wing, had a sharp one-two with Tim Knight before beating two defenders along the goal line then crossing for Brendan Hall to score.
- With the prospect of the game getting away from them Berkeley Vale hit back five minutes later when their exciting teenage striker Michael Tawyer pounced on a Killarney defensive error to score. The last chance of the first half came when Tim Knight turned the Wombats defence and played a delicate chip that beat the keeper only to rebound off the crossbar.
- The Terriers launched a series of attacks early in the second half without success before Berkeley Vale gradually began to take control. An incident in the 71st minute then proved crucial when a clear Killarney handball from a Berkeley free-kick 30 metres out went unpunished and from the resulting play Daniel Moffett broke through the centre setting up Andy Klijn to extend the Terriers lead to 3-1. Five minutes later replacement winger Blake Silvers then settled the title with a similar run down the middle of the field followed by a clinical finish. Darren Cooper then briefly revived the Wombats hopes with a headed goal in the 81st minute to bring the score to 4-2 but that was to be their last chance of the match.
- The 2018 Andrew French Medal was taken out by Andy Klijn who joined previous winners in teammates John Whelpdale (2016) and Daniel Moffett (2017).



- The Reserve Grade grand final was a triumph for two of the Wombats greatest ever players in David Graham and Brenton Olzomer, both former winners of the Premier League Player of the Year awards. Olzomer, the only player to have won both the POTY and Golden Boot returned this season from a long injury break, and scored two of the three goals in Berkeley's 3-1 win, the second during extra-time a classic that saw him break away from half-way before cutting back then beating the last defender and goalkeeper.
- Earlier Killarney District were stretched to the limit by a tenacious Umina team before winning the penalty shootout that gave them their third straight grand final win and their first league championship / premiership double.
