BACKGROUND

- The NSW Government has placed a “stay at home” order on the Greater Sydney Region (including the Central Coast) until Friday, 16 July 2021.
- During this time Community Sport has been shut down.
- There is no guarantee that the “stay at home” order will be lifted on Friday, 16 July 2021.
- There is also no guarantee that when the “stay at home” order is lifted, Community Sport will be able to immediately re-commence.
- Central Coast Football (CCF) have access to the Football Fields from Central Coast Council for competition games up until Sunday, 5 September 2021 and therefore all competition matches must be completed by that time.
- CCF has access to some fields beyond this (including Pluim Park) specifically for Final Series matches.
- CCF has formulated a Plan for the remainder of the 2021 competition that allows as many games as possible to be played within to time constraints.

- **For BPL, WPL and MDIV1 for the first 2 matches after restart interchange will apply before reverting back to 3 Substitutes as per the competition rules.**
