* If any game finishes as a draw after the final whistle, teams will go straight into a penalty shoot-out that will decide the winner. Penalties must be taken with a one-step kick. In a penalty shoot-out, each team takes turns shooting at goal from the penalty mark, with the goal only defended by the opposing team's selected goalkeeper. Each team has five shots which must be taken by different kickers; the team that makes more successful kicks is declared the victor. If scores are level after five pairs of shots, the shootout progresses into additional "sudden-death" rounds until a winner is crowned. *
