This position includes the following responsibilities;

- Oversee Junior player development
- Creation of talented player programs
- Mentoring of junior coaching staff throughout the club.
- Establish key stakeholder relationships.
- Recruit and encourage women to take up coaching roles
- Provide access to up to date information and professional development opportunities including observing senior coaches and model sessions.

YOUTH TECHNICAL DIRECTOR POSITION (Part-Time)

As this role within WFC includes operating as part of a team, the successful candidate is expected to work as a team member, show appropriate behaviours and respect to all our members and stakeholders, and work with high levels of collaboration and cooperation.

The successful candidate will embody our values of being transparent, inclusive, professional, respectful & connected to our local community.

PRIMARY OBJECTIVES

- The YTD is a paid position to oversee & manage our junior player development programs.
- The YTD is responsible for oversight of the U5's through to our U18 men & women's programs.
- The YTD will oversee performance and talented player programs, manage & mentor coaching staff throughout the club; assist with training sessions, grading days and other duties as designated by the football committee and or club executive.
- The YTD will assist with the compiling and updating of coaching manuals and coaching qualifications for club record

SPECIFIC ACCOUNTABILITIES

General

- Provide leadership & direction to coaching staff & recommendations to the committee.
- Establish and maintain strong relationships with relevant stakeholders including CCF, Football NSW/ FA, other clubs & our local development partners IE East Coast Soccer School
- Perform all duties as agreed upon and directed by the Committee of WFC
- Oversee and assist with grouping, grading & trial days. This includes introduction to parents and players, outlining programs and support throughout the year.

Performance Programs

- Oversee delivery of player development programs including relevant documentation that includes in season & out of season training programs.
- Oversee the Talent Identification process for Boys and Girls.
- Provide development opportunities in programs for all potential talented players.

Coach Development

- Oversee development, delivery & communication of Central Coast Football (CCF) courses.
- Create WhatsApp Channels for coaches with coaching resources, ideas, recommendations
- Encourage coaches to undertake coaching certificates and licences & record.
- Assist with training day sessions and programs.
- Attend home games where possible and provide match day support for coaches and monitor the progress of players.
- Be aware of and promote club code of conduct for coaches, players and parents at all times.
- Be aware of the club's child protection policy, health, and safety policy.
- Attend the monthly General Committee meeting.
- Assist coaches in the development and improvement of players technical ability.
- Develop and nurture talented players.
- Improve and develop coaching standards within the club. This includes increasing numbers of qualified coaches.
- Improve the level of satisfaction of coaches with support provided.
