



CCF Washout & Game Cancellation Policy

Effective from 12th August, 2025

1.0 Purpose

This policy aims to address the significant facility, competition and logistical challenges caused by adverse weather conditions so late into the 2025 season and provide certainty for our member clubs and participants.

Central Coast Footballs overarching goal is to create opportunity for as many football games to be played as possible throughout the remainder of the season.

2.0 Scope

This policy applies to all competition grades outlined in the below table.

Men's Premier League, Women's Premier League, Mens Under 23, Men's Division 1 and Women's Division 1 will continue to be rescheduled, as required for the remainder of the 2025 season.

3.0 Policy Statement

Washed out games in the above grades will no longer be rescheduled to a later date and will instead be deemed CANCELLED. Cancelled games will not count towards the competition ladder and will not have any result recorded.

All fixtures will continue to be updated in the CCF Competition management system, MyCompApp. When checking the draw on MyCompApp for the remainder of the season please note the status of your game:

- **PUBLISHED:** Means the game is going ahead as per the date, time and field details that appear.
- **CANCELLED:** Means the field is closed, the game is washed out and cancelled completely. No result will apply
- **POSTPONED:** Means the field is closed, the game is washed out, and will be rescheduled to a later date. This applies to MPL, WPL, DIV1 and WDIV1 only.
- **PLAYED:** Means the fixture has been completed and a score has been entered. Minirooms (U5-11) Will not be rescheduled, all matches have been published in the draw at the beginning of the season. These matches will be displayed as Played even if washed out.

CENTRAL COAST FOOTBALL

3.1 Change to Competition Ladders

To ensure we create opportunity for as many football games to be played as possible whilst maintaining competition integrity CCF has introduced a **POINTS PERCENTAGE** ladder calculation for the remainder of the 2025 season.

This format is the same methodology used in the previous seasons and eliminates a perceived unfairness if some teams play more games than others due to washouts. Cancelled games will be excluded from the calculation and the traditional POINTS column replaced with **POINTS PERCENTAGE**.

POINTS PERCENTAGE will be calculated by:

Total number of points won divided by the number of games played.

10 wins (30 points) + 5 draws (5 points) + 3 losses (0 points), divided by 18 (number of games played) = 1.944%

For example, the below M35CN competition:

- BUD M35CN - has won 21 points in their 15 games played. 21 divided by 15 = 1.400
- ENT M35CN - has won 20 points in their 13 games played. 20 divided by 13 = 1.538
- Even though BUD have more points, their **POINTS PERCENTAGE** is lower, therefore lower ladder position
